

The Royal College of Radiologists Aims and Objectives for Recertification

Following extensive consultation, the Royal College of Radiologists (RCR) has produced the following aims and objectives for recertification:

1. Designed to allow early warning of potential failure so remedial action can be taken in advance.
2. Allow all those, who are working at acceptable levels, to recertify without undue difficulty and stress.
3. Identify those whose practice falls below acceptable levels and give guidance on action and monitoring to allow recertification to be reconsidered.
4. Command the confidence of patients, the public and the profession.
5. Equitable across specialty, independent of differing areas of practice and working environments within and outside the UK.
6. Use existing tools and College standards and processes where appropriate.
7. Be affordable and flexible, starting simple to allow further development.
8. Encourage all Fellows and members continually to improve their practice.

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
