- Ethical approval






Gender Distribution of Responses (n=122)

Ethnicity Distribution of Participants (n=122)









52% experienced or witnessed sex discrimination


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
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Percentage of respondents





72% of respondents were NOT HAPPY with the way in which their situation was dealt with.

69% of respondents were NOT AWARE of a pathway in place of reporting such behaviours.

Discussion

Our results demonstrate sex discrimination, sexual harassment, and sexual assault are a significant problem in radiology training.

Discussion

- Disproportionately affects females
- Perpetrators are often seniors colleagues, but also patients
- Barriers to reporting issues
- Dissatisfied with the resolution

Next steps

- Must create safe working environments.
- Must create and raise awareness of pathways for reporting issues.
- Adequate training to be provided to staff to deal with situations appropriately.
