



The 2022 RCR Junior Radiologists' Forum Trainer Award

Many consultant radiologists dedicate their time and effort to deliver high quality teaching and training to radiology trainees. The purpose of this award is to identify and acknowledge those individuals whose hard work is often unrecognised.

The JRF Trainer Award, is presented annually to a UK-based consultant radiologist who has made an outstanding contribution to radiology teaching and training at a local, regional, or national level.

All nominations will be considered by the JRF Executive Committee, and a worthy recipient will be selected. Should a member of the Executive feel they have a conflict of interest, they are obliged to declare this. In the event of a tie, the Chair will have the casting vote.

The award will be acknowledged in the JRF section of the RCR Newsletter and on the RCR website. All nominated trainers will receive a letter of commendation from the JRF, and the winner will be presented with an engraved trophy.

The process of nomination, selection, and presentation of the JRF Trainer Award is, and shall remain, the responsibility of the incumbent JRF Executive Committee. Any decision made by this group shall be separate from any other committee within, or other award(s) issued by, the RCR.
