Physics Module: Instructions for Candidates

Please read, and comply with, the following instructions. The invigilator will also announce the most important points. Please listen carefully.

- You are expected to behave in a reasonable and respectful manner throughout the examination period. You must comply with the instructions and requirements of the examination invigilators at all times.
- If you have a query during the examination, please remain silently at your desk, raise your hand and wait for an invigilator to come to you.
- You are allowed two hours to answer the Physics question paper.
- You will be provided with a question paper (in booklet form) and a separate answer sheet. Do not bend, crease or fold the answer sheet - you will only be given one sheet.
- Write your candidate number on the question paper in the space provided.
- Your answer sheet will be marked by computer. To ensure your sheet is acceptable:
 - Only use an HB pencil. Use firm pressure. Do not use too sharp a pencil. Amend mistakes carefully using an eraser, avoiding smudges.
- Write your name in the space at the top right hand corner of the answer sheet, and your candidate number in the space at the top right hand corner of the answer sheet. In addition, complete the appropriate boxes to represent your candidate number (see sample answer sheet overleaf).
- There is no restriction on the number of true and false answers for a question; all may be true or all may be false.
- For each question item indicate whether the answer is true or false by marking either the [T] lozenge or the [F] lozenge respectively (see sample answer sheet overleaf).
- You should answer all questions. The examination is not negatively marked. Incorrect responses will be awarded a score of zero.
- If you indicate your answers on the question paper in the first instance, ensure that you leave yourself enough time to transfer these to the answer sheet. You will not be given extra time to do this. Answers written on the question paper will not be marked.
- At the end of the examination, hand your question paper and answer sheet to the invigilator.
- If you attempt to make a copy of any part of the question paper you will be disqualified. If you allow your mobile telephone, or other device, to emit an audible sound during any component of the examination you will be disqualified.
