

RCR / BSBR Travelling Professorship 2022/23

Background:

This visiting Professorship is jointly funded by the RCR and BSBR to highlight the role of breast radiology within the UK.

Nature:

The visiting professor will be expected to undertake 6-8 visits to training programmes, over a period of 12 months (starting in September 2022), to deliver lectures and undertake appropriate workshops or small group teaching as part of each visit. One lecture will be recorded and made available online, which can be delivered as a webinar.

The purpose of the visits is educational: to raise the profile of breast imaging amongst trainees, to highlight the rewards of a career in breast radiology, and to foster high quality breast imaging throughout the UK. Applications are invited from experienced breast radiologists who can provide valuable insights into day-to-day breast imaging practice as well as those who have a particular field of expertise or academic research.

At the end of the professorship, the successful candidate will be required to deliver a lecture at the next BSBR annual meeting.

Funding:

Up to £5,000

Eligibility:

The professorship is open to breast radiologists who are Fellows of the RCR in good standing, members of the BSBR, resident in the United Kingdom and in active clinical practice at the time of the application and the award/visits.

To apply:

Candidates should submit; a current curriculum vitae; a 200-400 word description of the applicant's teaching record and a description of why they would be suitable for the professorship; and a list of proposed workshop/lecture titles suitable for presentation to the training programmes.

An Appointments Board combined of members of the Royal College of Radiologists and the British Society of Breast Radiology will consider applications. The decision of the Appointments Board is final and binding, applicants will be informed of the outcome as soon as possible after the decision has been approved.
